MR A POWELL asked the Deputy Premier and Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier detail the timeframe for the pending review of the South East Queensland Regional Plan and, if that timeframe won't see the review completed within two years, will the Deputy Premier consider specific amendments sooner?

ANSWER:

Regional plans are reviewed generally every five to seven years. The South East Queensland Regional Plan 2017 (*ShapingSEQ*), which was released in August 2017, states that a review of *ShapingSEQ* will see a new plan delivered between 2022 and 2024. Amendments to regional plans are not considered outside of a review.
