**MR R KATTER** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH) –

## QUESTION

With reference to Queensland Children's Gender Service, which on its website is describes 'being trans or gender diverse ... as part of the natural spectrum of human diversity'—

Will the Minister outline the number of (a) patients the service has treated in the last five years by age and (b) children have been prescribed puberty-blocking drugs and/or irreversible cross-sex hormones?

## ANSWER

I am advised that the Queensland Children's Gender Service integrated with the Enterprise Scheduling Management system commenced in October 2017 at the Queensland Children's Hospital, meaning robust treatment data became available from that time. I am further advised that prescription data became available from April 2018.

(a) Please note, data about 'patients the service has treated' is reported as:

- New referrals received, triaged and accepted per year; and
- Total number of patients receiving care (across multiple years).
