

## **Question on Notice**

**Asked on 13 May 2021**

**MR N DAMETTO** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH) –

### **QUESTION**

With reference to international pilots in Queensland who reside outside of the Greater Brisbane area —

Will the Minister advise how many pilots to date have (a) breached (i) a quarantine/self-isolation order, (ii) stringent hotel quarantine abroad, (b) tested positive for COVID-19 (i) since the directives were in place and (ii) and have conducted repatriation flights?

### **ANSWER**

With respect to the Member's question, I am advised as that in relation to (a)(i), this query would more appropriately be directed to the Queensland Police Service.

In relation to part (a)(ii) of the question, I am advised the Queensland Government is not privy to the rate of compliance for international jurisdictions' quarantine system, and cannot answer the question.

Regarding b(i), I am advised as at 19 May 2021, there had been six COVID-19 cases notified to Queensland Health since the start of the pandemic which identified their occupation as being an international pilot. Of these cases, three were international pilots who reside outside of the Greater Brisbane area.

In response to b(ii), I have been advised that the Commonwealth Government manages international repatriation flights and inquires for the information request would be most appropriately to the Commonwealth.
