MR B MICKELBERG ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND SMALL BUSINESS AND MINISTER FOR TRAINING AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT (HON D FARMER) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the number of employers currently participating in the Back to Work program as well as the number of supported employees (broken down by SA4 region)?

ANSWER:

I am pleased to advise that since 2016, the Back to Work (BTW) program has supported over 25,000 job seekers and 11,964 employers to employ Queenslanders who have experienced a period of unemployment (as at 18 June 2021).

Queensland's unemployment rate is now down to 5.4%, its lowest level in almost a decade.

There are currently 2,225 employers participating in the BTW program (this is based on active applications as at 18 June 2021).

The following table represents the total number of job seekers currently supported and broken down by SA4 region (as at 18 June 2021):
