**MR M CRANDON** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND SMALL BUSINESS AND MINISTER FOR TRAINING AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT (HON D FARMER) —

### QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide TAFE Queensland's profit or loss for each financial year from 2015-16 onwards, including the current projected profit or loss for this financial year?

### ANSWER:

The TAFE Queensland audited financial statements for each financial year from 2014-15 are contained in TAFE Queensland's annual reports that are tabled in the Queensland Parliament.
