**MR D CRISAFULLI** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH) –

### **QUESTION**

Will the Minister advise the average, median, and longest ambulance arrival times for all services in the Metro South LASN (broken down by suburb and month) in the period 1 July 2019 to 1 May 2021?

### **ANSWER**

The Queensland Ambulance Service (QAS) reports against approved performance measures for all dispatch codes. These measures do not include average, median and longest ambulance arrival times.

I have been advised for dispatch Codes 1A to 2A, the approved measures reflect the response times at the 50th and 90th percentile, which is the time (in minutes) within which 50 per cent and 90 per cent of the first responding ambulance resources arrive at the scene. This has been one of the QAS approved performance measures since 2008-09.
