MR M BOOTHMAN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)

QUESTION:

With reference to Question on Notice No. 334 for 2021—

Will the Minister inform residents what options have been identified to mitigate the impact of flood events on the existing station and when will funds be allocated so mitigation works can begin?

ANSWER:

I am advised by Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) that independent advice was sought to determine the appropriate course of action, which includes the relocation of a wall and the application of a protective coating to required surfaces. I am also advised that the brigade considers this mitigation action to be appropriate.

I am further advised that works have commenced on these rectification measures, with \$15,000 allocated by QFES to complete the works.

I have been assured that QFES will continue to provide support to the brigade in relation to this matter.
