**MR L MILLAR** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise why the Queensland Government webpage shows the Queensland Government Agent Program (QGAP) office in Isisford as having closed on 3 September 2015 when it was still in operation until some 21 months ago and when the Queensland Government will restore the operations of the QGAP office in Isisford?

ANSWER:

Although the Queensland Government Agent Program (QGAP) in Isisford was co-located within the Isisford Police Station, I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the QPS is not responsible for determining the locations of QGAP offices.

Accordingly, the Member should direct his question to the relevant Minister responsible for QGAP.
