MR D PEGG ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise of the nature of the 3 offences at PARC Sunnybank Hills reported to the Queensland Police Service between 1 January 2020 and 25 July 2020 and also whether any charges were laid by the Queensland Police Service in relation to these offences?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that between 1 January 2020 and 25 July 2020 there were four reported offences at PARC, Sunnybank Hills.

I am informed by the QPS that the PARC Sunnybank Hills complex has two street addresses as it is a multi-stage development.

The QPS has advised the following three offences were recorded under one address:

- Two drug related offences. One person was charged in relation to this matter.
- One person obstructing police offence. One person was formally charged.

In addition, the QPS has advised that one offence, relating to a stealing matter, has been identified as being recorded under another address and that no formal charges were forthcoming from this matter.
