QUESTION:

With reference to the government's \$30m Great Keppel Island revitalisation project—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by year for 2017-2021) (a) to date, what is the final breakdown of yearly expenditure (b) how much of this total expenditure has been spent (i) on Queensland Government staff travel, accommodation and hospitality, (ii) infrastructure on Island and (iii) with businesses in the Rockhampton and Capricorn Coast region?
