QUESTION

With reference to the 'Clinical Safety Review' of Pelvic Exenteration surgeries at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital—

Will the Minister advise (a) the total cost of the review undertaken by the external colorectal surgeon, (b) the outcome of the review and (c) whether Pelvic Exenteration surgeries will be available at any Queensland public hospital following the review?

ANSWER

The total cost of the review undertaken by the external colorectal surgeon was \$10,406.17 (includes GST) including costs associated with travel and accommodation.

I am advised that the Metro North Hospital and Health Service has received the report and its clinical team is reviewing the content in conjunction with the Department of Health.
