MS A CAMM ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister provide (reported separately by HHS and hospital) the number of (a) doctors and (b) nurses trained to perform a forensic medical examination?

ANSWER

I am advised that the term “forensic medical examination” may generically refer to a range of examinations, such as sexual assault forensic examinations, post-mortem examinations or specimen collection for toxicology.

As it is unclear what type of training is specifically referred to in the question, I am unable to provide any further information.
