**MR S O'CONNOR** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF AND MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND YOUTH AFFAIRS (HON M SCANLON)—

### QUESTION:

Will the Minister outline (reported separately by year) for the last five years (a) how much State Government funding is currently provided to Life Sciences Queensland and (b) how much has previously been provided?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Department of Environment and Science (DES) is not primarily responsible for the provision of funding for operational support to Life Sciences Queensland (LSQ).

Funding has been for time-bound projects delivered by LSQ, and for membership fees and attendance at events, as outlined below.
