**MR B HEAD** ASKED MINISTER FOR ENERGY, RENEWABLES AND HYDROGEN AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND PROCUREMENT (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to the Queensland Energy and Jobs Plan referring to household electricity bills being \$150 lower annually in 2032—

Will the Minister advise what modelling this is based on and will this modelling be released?

**ANSWER**

The Queensland Government engaged EY to undertake independent expert modelling to support the development of the Queensland Energy and Jobs Plan and understand the benefits of the Plan for Queensland.

The EY report, titled *The Queensland Energy and Jobs Plan – electricity market and economic modelling outcomes*, has been made publicly available and outlines the modelling assumptions.
