With reference to local community concerns and potential environmental impacts related to flight paths of both the Brisbane Airport and Archerfield Airport—

Will the Minister outline the collaborative work being undertaken by the Department of Environment and Science with any other agencies and/or levels of government including the Brisbane City Council and the Federal Government, to address such concerns?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Department of Environment and Science does not regulate federal airports, including the Brisbane and Archerfield airports.

Brisbane and Archerfield airports do not have environmental authorities regulated by the Department of Environment and Science, and the department does not regulate aircraft noise from these sites.
