1133     **MR J LANGBROEK** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SENIORS AND DISABILITY SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS (HON C CRAWFORD)

With reference to annual report 2021-22, P40—

Will the Minister advise (a) the location of the 38 houses made available for ownership by Aboriginal people and Torres Strait Islander people and (b) what is the target for 2022-23?

**Answer:**

- (a)     During the 2021-22 period, 38 houses were made available for ownership by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples across 12 communities including 25 in the Torres Strait Island region and 13 in mainland Queensland.

The breakdown by community is as follows:

Torres Strait Island region:

- Boigu Island – 15
- Mabuiag Island – 3
- Masig Island – 1
- Poruma Island – 1
- Saibai Island – 1
- St Pauls Community (on Moa Island) – 2
- Warraber Island – 2.

Mainland communities:

- Doomadgee – 1
- Kowanyama – 3
- Lockhart River – 3
- Mapoon – 1
- Pormpuraaw – 5.

- (b)     While no longer a deliverable under the Service Delivery Statements, the department is committed to continuing to make house available for home ownership by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in targeted communities through Queensland Government investment in the 2022-23 period.
