MR R STEVENS ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the maximum number of RoadTek employees that have been approved for home garaging of a government owned vehicle (reported separately for each financial year from 2016–17 to present)?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mermaid Beach for the question.

RoadTek is permanently based in over 40 locations across Queensland and plays a critical role in responding to and connecting communities, particularly in times of natural disaster. RoadTek's operations in many of the locations, particularly in the southern half of the state, are 24 hours a day, seven days a week, with project delivery and incident response delivered both during the day and night.

As at 23 September 2022, RoadTek had 1332 full-time equivalents. The home garaging numbers includes long term, short term, on-call and temporary on-call approvals, and covers the various working arrangements by RoadTek crews needing to home garage a government-owned vehicle.

The below table shows the maximum number of employees with approved home garaging arrangements at any point of time throughout the financial year. The table also includes the corresponding QFleet vehicles allocated to RoadTek.
