MR D JANETZKI ASKED TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INVESTMENT (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the use of agency temps to backfill vacant positions in the Queensland Revenue Office referenced on page 73 of Queensland Treasury's 2021-22 Annual Report—

Will the Treasurer advise (a) how many agency temps have been used from 1 July 2021 to present, (b) how many hours have been worked by agency temps from 1 July 2021 to present and (c) what was the highest number of agency temps used at any given time between 1 July 2021 and present and when was that time?

ANSWER:

From 1 July 2021 to 30 September 2022, the Queensland Revenue Office has utilised the services of 50 agency temps to backfill vacant public service positions in the Queensland Revenue Office.

The QRO does not centrally record an aggregate number of hours worked by agency temporary staff.

During this period, the highest number of agency temps engaged by the Queensland Revenue Office backfilling vacant public service roles at any one time was 31. This occurred on two occasions: 30-31 August 2021 and 16-27 September 2021.
