MR T MANDER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND HOUSING, MINISTER FOR DIGITAL ECONOMY AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

# QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the number of social housing tenancies with a combined gross assessable income (for all tenants and their partners) more than \$80,000 per year, as at 30 September 2022 (reported separately by Housing Service Centre)?

### ANSWER:

As at 30 September 2022, there are 197 households or 0.36% of Government owned and managed public housing tenancies Statewide where the tenant/s and/or spouse combined gross assessable income is \$80 000 or greater per annum. The number of households with a combined gross assessable income (for all tenants and their partners) more than \$80,000 has reduced by 74 households since 31 January 2022.

The department continues to actively work with people, including social housing tenants, to respond to their needs and activate a range of housing assistance and support solutions.

For privacy reasons, the department is unable to release data by Housing Service Centre due to risk of identification.
