DR M ROBINSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to the presently stalled Stage 1 upgrades at Redland Hospital—Will the Minister advise (a) if the former Federal government's \$30m commitment has been confirmed in the 2022 Federal Budget and (b) when the \$30m will be made available?

ANSWER

The premise of the question is incorrect. Stage 1 has not stalled. On 22 November I announced the awarding of the contract for Stage 1 to ADCO.

I am advised that the Commonwealth Government has paid \$16.8 million to the Queensland Government for the Redland Hospital Stage 1 Expansion project. A further \$13.2 million is payable on acceptance of a progress report for the project. The Queensland Government is currently finalising this report for submission to the Commonwealth Government.

The full \$30 million will be provided once project milestones have been realised.
