MR T NICHOLLS asked the Minister for Children and Youth Justice and Minister for Multicultural Affairs (HON L LINARD)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise how many GPS monitoring device trackers have been fitted on youth offenders since April 2021 by (a) Townsville, (b) North Brisbane, (c) Moreton, (d) Logan and (e) Gold Coast?

ANSWER

The Palaszczuk Government is committed to reducing offending and reoffending and keeping the community safe.

The Department of Children, Youth Justice and Multicultural Affairs; Department of Justice and Attorney-General; Queensland Police Service; and Queensland courts all play a significant role in addressing youth crime.

As the Queensland Police Service is responsible for fitting electronic monitoring devices, this question should be directed to the Honourable Mark Ryan MP, Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services.
