**MR D JANETZKI** asked the Minister for Children and Youth Justice and Minister for Multicultural Affairs (HON L LINARD)—

### QUESTION

With reference to the number of residential care facilities operating in Toowoomba and the South West Region—

Will the Minister advise the total number of calls for service to police in relation to these facilities in the past two years (reported separately by suburb and year)?

### ANSWER

As at 1 November 2022, there are 95 licensed residential care facilities in the South West Region.

The Department of Children, Youth Justice and Multicultural Affairs (DCYJMA) provides an annual list of residential care services to the Queensland Police Service (QPS). There is a joint agency protocol between QPS and DCYJMA to reduce preventable police call outs.

DCYJMA does not hold data on the number of calls for service to police in relation to these facilities.
