## QUESTION:

Will the Premier provide the forecast Queensland public sector workforce profile as of March 2023, broken down by role in the same format as shown on page 9 of the March 2022 Queensland Public Sector Workforce Profile?

## ANSWER:

I am advised by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet (DPC) and the Public Service Commission (PSC) that forecasts of the Queensland public sector workforce profile broken down in the same format as shown on page 9 of the March 2022 Queensland Public Sector Workforce Profile are not centrally collected from across the public sector by DPC or the PSC.

The Queensland public sector workforce profile as of March 2023 will be published by the PSC as soon as possible after March 2023.

The Member for Lockyer may wish to note that Full Time Equivalent (FTE) positions by department budgeted for as part of the Queensland Budget 2022-23, are outlined in Table 5.2 on page 121 of Budget Paper No. 2 that the Treasurer and Minister for Trade and Investment tabled on 21 June 2022.
