MR T MANDER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND HOUSING, MINISTER FOR DIGITAL ECONOMY AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Department of Communities, Housing and Digital Economy budget highlights outlined on page 2 of the 2021-22 Service Delivery Statement—Will the Minister provide the following for the \$54.9m allocated for 'continuing services through the First Housing Action Plan 2017-2020' (a) a list of programs being funded and (b) the dollar value of funds allocated to each program being funded?

ANSWER:

In the 2021-22 State Budget, the Queensland Government committed an additional \$54.9 million over four years for essential housing and homelessness services launched through the first Housing Action Plan 2017–2020.

This included \$30.8 million for Homelessness Programs, \$2.9 million for Homelessness and Housing Sector Bodies and Evaluation, \$11.5 million for Coordinated Housing and Homeless Responses, \$4.5 million for Supportive Housing for Families, \$4.6 million for Private Housing Programs and \$0.6 million for One Home Trial.
