MR S BENNETT ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to Bundaberg Hospital—

Will the Minister provide (a) staff currently on leave or absent (reported separately by staff roles i.e. nurse, doctor etc), (b) total number of reported assaults on staff this year (reported separately by staff roles) and (c) number of staff on leave or absent as a result of workplace assault?

ANSWER

At the outset I would like to commend the dedication our staff bring, everyday to the workplace, to care for their patients and community.

I would also reiterate that any form of occupational violence is not just "part of the job" and no Queensland Health staff should be subjected to abuse, harassment, threatening behaviour or assault by patients, consumers, their relatives or members of the public, irrespective of the intent for harm.
