# **QUESTION**

With reference to the Rockhampton Hospital maternity ward— Will the Minister provide (reported separately by calendar month) from 1 January 2022 (a) the number budgeted FTE Nursing and Midwife positions, (b) the number of actual FTE Nursing and Midwife positions filled, (c) the number of budgeted FTE Medical positions and (d) the number of actual FTE Medical positions filled?
