MR J MCDONALD ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES
AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 965 of 2022— Will the Minister advise of the 9,413 new weapons licensing applications, how many are from weapons holders who have failed to renew their licenses prior to the expiry date?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that to provide the number of weapons holders who have failed to renew their licenses prior to the expiry date would require a manual examination of new weapons licence applications records in two separate systems. This is considered an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.
