**MS R BATES** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

### QUESTION

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 744 of 2022—

Will the Minister provide the state-wide percentage of Patient Off Stretcher Times (POST) achieved within 30 minutes (reported separately by calendar month from July to November 2022)?

### ANSWER

The 'Queensland Hospital Performance' website lists quarterly Patient Off Stretcher Time Performance for Queensland's 26 largest public hospitals.

The table below reports the percentage of POST in under 30 minutes, by calendar month for Queensland Health's reportable hospitals (Top 26) from July 2022 to September 2022.

As the Member will be aware, Queensland experienced its third Omicron wave throughout the month of July. This significantly impacted the availability of hospital beds as well as increasing the rate of who were furloughed due to illness.
