MR R STEVENS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to Queensland Audit Office Report 8: 2021-22 (improving access to specialist outpatient services), and the Referral Services Directory (RSD) project identified in the report—

Will the Minister provide (a) a list of Hospital and Health Services which now have completed the rollout of the RSD, (b) the initial project budget of the RSD project and (c) total expenditure to date on the RSD project?

ANSWER

In relation to the Referral Services Directory (RSD) project, I have been advised by the department of the following:

- (a) The RSD is available at all sixteen (16) Hospital and Health Services (HHSs) and Mater Health (publicly funded services).
- (b) The initial project budget to support project delivery of the RSD was \$5.315 million.
- (c) Total expenditure, as of the end of October 2022 was \$5.31 million for initial project delivery.
