MR J LANGBROEK ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TOURISM, INNOVATION AND SPORT AND MINISTER ASSISTING THE PREMIER ON OLYMPICS AND PARALYMPICS SPORT AND ENGAGEMENT (HON S HINCHLIFFE) —

QUESTION:

Will the Minister detail the costs for the department associated with the 2022 Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500?

ANSWER:

The Department of Tourism, Innovation and Sport's costs for the 2022 Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500 were \$2,082.96 comprising:

- \$2,003.45 for placing public notices about the regulation of the event (as required under the *Major Events Act 2014*) in the Gold Coast Bulletin and the Courier Mail; and
- \$79.51 for the mandatory printing of and supply to Parliament House for the *Major Events (Gold Coast 500) Regulation 2022*.

Tourism and Events Queensland (TEQ) is a statutory body of the Queensland Government and the State's lead marketing, destination and experience development and major events agency. TEQ supported the 2022 Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500 via its major event investment program. This cost was not incurred by the Department of Tourism, Innovation and Sport.
