MR S KNUTH asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympics Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the \$100m Resource Community Infrastructure Fund having been discontinued by the State Government, after 2 rounds of funding, despite the Resource Industry explicitly wishing to continue its contribution of \$70m to the fund—

Will the Deputy Premier explain why regional communities will now again miss out and be denied access to \$100m in funding and if, or what funding avenues will now replace the Resource Community Infrastructure Fund?
