MR S MINNIKIN ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the costs incurred to date for the tender process for the Rockhampton Ring Road project?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Chatsworth for the question.

The tender process is still in progress, however, the cost-to-date is \$4.5 million.

The Palaszczuk Government is delivering its seventh record transport and roads infrastructure program in a row, as detailed in the *Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2022–23 to 2025–26*, which outlines \$29.7 billion in investment over the next four years and is estimated to support an average of 25,200 direct jobs over the life of the program. Of this, \$1.525 billion is committed across the Department of Transport and Main Roads' Fitzroy District, estimated to support an average of 1380 direct jobs over the life of the program.
