MR T WATTS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

# **QUESTION**

With reference to youth mental health—

Will the Minister advise (a) how many beds are currently in the youth mental health ward at the Toowoomba Hospital, (b) over the last 24 months (reported monthly) how many beds were available and (c) upon completion of the new Tertiary Hospital at Baillie Henderson, how many beds will be on the Youth Mental Health ward?

# **ANSWER**

- (a) I am advised by the Darling Downs Hospital and Health Service that there are eight specialised child and adolescent acute psychiatric beds at Toowoomba Hospital.
- (b) The following tables provide the number of beds, beds occupied, and beds unoccupied, by month since October 2020 for the Child and Youth Mental Health Service at Toowoomba Hospital.
