DR M ROBINSON ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the growth of faith-based Schools in the non-government sector over the last seven years by (a) number of students and cost to the Education budget to educate them (total State Government funding allocated to these schools) (reported annually and per category of school i.e. Catholic, Other Christian, Muslim, Jewish, Other) and (b) list of faith-based schools the minister has visited personally in her time as the Education minister (reported annually)?

ANSWER:

The Australian Government is the majority funder of non-state schools.

The Department of Education does not collect information under the category of 'faith-based' schools. The Non-State Schools Accreditation Board asks schools to nominate a category of Type of School related to the type of school as portrayed by the school's philosophical, religious, educational and/or cultural foundations. However, there is no category of 'faith based' school.

State recurrent funding is based on each school's needs profile (socio-economic status, school resource index and school location) and student needs profile (students with a disability, recipients of boarding fee concessions, students with English as a second language, students from isolated areas, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students).

As at February 2022, there were 544 accredited non-state schools with approximately 297,550 funded students.
