MR A PERRETT ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to the fracture clinic at Gympie hospital

Will the Minister (a) advise the dates and times it has been open for service since January 2022 and (b) provide the data on the number of Gympie patients treated at the Sunshine Coast University Hospital for fracture related issues (reported separately by month since January 2022)?

ANSWER

The Gympie Hospital Fracture Clinic operated a weekly clinic until May 2022, when a shortage of Medical Officers forced its temporary closure.

Historically, regional areas have found it challenging to recruit and retain skilled health workers. This was further impacted by COVID-19 and is not unique to the Sunshine Coast region.

The Fracture Clinic reopened with a fortnightly service on 13 July 2022, however, it is expected to return to a weekly service in February 2023.

I am advised 843 fracture clinic appointments have been provided at Gympie Hospital from 5 January 2022 to 16 November 2022.

The number of appointments for those residing in Gympie, who have been reviewed in the Fracture Clinic at Sunshine Coast University Hospital since 5 January 2022 to 16 November 2022 is:
