MR R KATTER asked the Minister for Children and Youth Justice and Minister for Multicultural Affairs (HON L LINARD)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by year since 2015) what percentage of recidivist juvenile offenders dealt with under the Queensland Youth Justice System have reoffended after turning 18?

ANSWER

The Department of Children, Youth Justice and Multicultural Affairs holds data in relation to young people aged 10-17 years.

Data regarding offenders aged 18 and over is held by the Queensland Police Service. This question should be directed to the Honourable Mark Ryan MP, Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services.
