MR J MCDONALD ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise what investment the West Moreton HHS and Darling Downs HHS have made to improve the Laidley and Gatton Hospitals since 2015 by year?

ANSWER

I have been advised by West Moreton Hospital and Health Service that since 2015, \$1,653,390 has been invested for capital works and renewals at Gatton Hospital and \$811,741 has been invested for capital works and renewals at Laidley Hospital.

These works have included extensive renovations to Gatton Hospital in 2015-16, a complete refurbishment of the emergency department at Gatton Hospital in 2020-21, a major upgrade to the fire mitigation system at Laidley Hospital in 2020-21, and a sophisticated duress alarm system for staff at both hospitals in 2021-22.

The following table shows investment in capital works and infrastructure improvements at Gatton Hospital and Laidley Hospital since 2015-16:
