

## **Question on Notice**

**Asked on 30 November 2022**

**MR J BLEIJIE** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympics Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

**QUESTION:**

Will the Deputy Premier advise the 2021-22 actual expenditure and 2022-23 forecast expenditure for the Indigenous Councils Critical Infrastructure Program?

**ANSWER:**

The Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning expended \$12,348,304.40 to councils for delivery of Indigenous Councils Critical Infrastructure Program projects in financial year 2021-22.

Based on Budget Paper 3, the forecast expenditure for financial year 2022-23 is \$22,324,000.

Where project delivery milestones are achieved more slowly than forecast, this results in fewer payments to councils during the financial year than budgeted. This funding is still available to councils and is carried forward to future years.
