**Mr J Krause** asked Premier and Minister for the Olympics (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier provide the attrition rate for staff across the Department of the Premier and Cabinet (reported separately by service area and year for the last five years)?

ANSWER: (Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games):

The Public Service Commission, on behalf of the Queensland Government, is responsible for the collection and maintenance of public service workforce information as part of the Government approved Minimum Obligatory Human Resource Information (MOHRI) process.

Attrition, or separation rates as they are termed, for the staff of government departments, are collected as part of the MOHRI process. For the purposes of the MOHRI process, a separation is when a permanent employee leaves the Queensland Government.

MOHRI separation data is collected at departmental level and is not available at a service area level for the Department of the Premier and Cabinet.

On this basis, I am advised that the separation rate for the Department of the Premier and Cabinet was 3.84% in 2017-18, 4.70% in 2018-19, 4.46% in 2019-20, 3.21% in 2020-21 and 2.83% in 2021-22.
