MRS L GERBER ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Light Rail proposed station at Warner Street, Coolangatta—

Will the Minister advise what measures TMR has put in place to mitigate the impacts of flooding?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Currumbin for the question.

The Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 4 (GCLR4) is currently in the preliminary business case phase of the project lifecycle. The preliminary business case is due for completion in mid-2023.

The preliminary business case will inform a decision about whether to proceed with a detailed business case. During the detailed business case process, matters requiring mitigation are identified, such as the matter raised by the member in this Question on Notice and mitigations for those matters are then implemented in the project design.
