

## Question on Notice

**MR T MANDER** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND HOUSING, MINISTER FOR DIGITAL ECONOMY AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Housing Strategy 2017-2020 Action Plan and in relation to the commitment that 50 percent of Public Housing would be built to Liveable Housing Design Guidelines Gold Level or Platinum Level standards—  
Will the Minister advise, per calendar year since 2017 (a) the percentage of dwellings constructed to Gold or Platinum standards and (b) the number of dwellings constructed to Gold or Platinum standards?

ANSWER:

The department aims to achieve 50 percent of the total construction completions each financial year to be built to a Gold or Platinum Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines.

In 2017 the department completed the construction of 342 dwellings through capital works and capital grants. Of these 95 were built to a Platinum Level and 89 were built to a Gold Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines. This equates to 54 percent.

In 2018 the department completed the construction of 491 dwellings through capital works and capital grants. Of these 144 were built to a Platinum Level and 187 were built to a Gold Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines. This equates to 67 percent.

In 2019 the department completed the construction of 526 dwellings through capital works and capital grants. Of these 73 were built to a Platinum Level and 317 were built to a Gold Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines. This equates to 74 percent.

In 2020 the department completed the construction of 560 dwellings through capital works and capital grants. Of these 89 were built to a Platinum Level and 272 were built to a Gold Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines. This equates to 64 percent.

In 2021 the department completed the construction of 602 dwellings through capital works and capital grants. Of these 90 were built to a Platinum Level and 394 were built to a Gold Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines. This equates to 80 percent.

In 2022, as at 30 November 2022, the department completed the construction of 309 dwellings through capital works and capital grants. Of these 58 were built to a Platinum Level and 110 were built to a Gold Level of accessibility under the Liveable Housing Design Guidelines. This equates to 54 percent.
