DR A MACMAHON ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

With reference to the Bilateral Agreement between Queensland and the Commonwealth on Implementation of School Education Reform that expires on 31 December 2023—

Will the Minister confirm the timeline and progress of the re-negotiation of this bilateral agreement with the Commonwealth Government?

ANSWER:

The current National School Reform Agreement (NSRA) and associated state and territory Bilateral Agreements are set to expire in December 2023.

At the Education Ministers Meeting on 15 December 2022, Australian, state and territory Government Education Ministers agreed to undertake a review to inform the next NSRA.

Subject to agreement from governments, it is expected that the NSRA and associated Bilateral Agreements will be extended for 12 months to allow time for this review to take place. No timeline is available for the negotiation.
