MR A POWELL ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the current wait time for a driving test at each Transport and Main Roads customer service centre (CSC) in South East Queensland?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Glass House for the question.

Following the recent South East Queensland (SEQ) floods and ongoing staffing impacts due to the COVID-19 pandemic, practical driving test lead times are currently longer. In order to assist with this, additional car tests are currently available on Saturdays at select testing locations.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) has also temporarily extended this service to include some Saturday heavy vehicle test bookings from 9 April to 4 June 2022.

The current wait times as of 28 April 2022 for both car and heavy rigid (HR) practical driving tests at each TMR testing location in SEQ are provided in the below table.
