QUESTION

With reference to Metro South staff, including nurses, having been told that if they take an overseas holiday they have to quarantine for 2 weeks at their own expense when they return— Will the Minister advise why are they being treated differently to the rest of Queensland?

ANSWER

I am advised that Healthcare staff returning to Queensland from overseas are subject to the same quarantine requirements as all other international arrivals.
