MR S MINNIKIN ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to each Australian Transport Safety Bureau (ATSB) investigation into an incident involving Queensland Rail assets since 2017—

Will the Minister provide (a) the date and nature of the incident, (b) the date that the ATSB report was provided to Queensland Rail and (c) details of any recommendations in the ATSB report, including the date that Queensland Rail implemented the recommendations?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Chatsworth for the question.

Safety is Queensland Rail's utmost priority. Queensland Rail reports all notifiable incidents under the Rail Safety Legislation to the Office of the National Safety Regulator (ONRSR). ONRSR shares this reporting incident with the Australian Transport Safety Bureau (ATSB).

The ATSB's primary focus is on enhancing safety and, in particular, those transport safety matters that may present a significant concern to public safety and are the subject of widespread public interest. The ATSB reviews reported incidents and undertakes investigations in accordance with the ATSB's priorities for investigating. Queensland Rail is committed to cooperating fully with any ATSB investigations.

The ATSB report does not specify recommendations. Queensland Rail works in collaboration with the ATSB throughout its investigation to implement Queensland Rail initiated action items progressively following an incident. The below table outlines the status of Queensland Rail's action items that the ATSB has outlined in their reports.
