DR A MACMAHON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND HOUSING, MINISTER FOR DIGITAL ECONOMY AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the net number of social housing dwellings operated by the community-managed housing sector for each of the following periods (a) 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2019, (b) 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2020, (c) 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021 and (d) 1 January 2022 to the present?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Queensland Government is continuing to deliver social and affordable housing, providing safe and secure housing to vulnerable Queenslanders and supporting Queensland jobs. The Department of Communities, Housing and Digital Economy is partnering with the community housing sector to provide new and innovative housing support and a strong community housing sector capable of increasing supply through QuickStarts Qld.

The number of social housing dwellings in Queensland that are community managed include from 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2019 there were 13,431, 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2020 there were 13,868, 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021 there were 13,957 and from 1 January 2022 to 30 April 2022 there were 13,946.
