MR D LAST ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to Commissioner Stewart's testimony, at the Estimates hearing on 12 August 2021, that Corrections aimed 'to complete the Queensland Parole System Review (QPSR) program, all the recommendations that we can, by 30 June next year'—

Will the Minister advise (a) how many recommendations of the Sofronoff review, accepted by government, have not yet been completed and (b) will funding for the implementation the outstanding recommendations be extended beyond 30 June 2022?

ANSWER:

I am advised by Queensland Corrective Services that it is expected that all recommendations accepted by government will be completed or closed by 30 June 2022.

I am also advised, that further to the initial \$265 million funding package for the implementation of the QPSR recommendations, the government has committed recurrent funding of \$62.7 million per year. This commitment will ensure that the system level enhancements are continued to be realised, improving community safety for all Queenslanders. in

In addition to the recurrent funding previously announced, in this year's budget the government has committed increased funding of \$33.6 million over 4 years and \$6.1 million per annum ongoing to further enhance this work.
