**MS A CAMM** asked the Minister for Children and Youth Justice and Minister for Multicultural Affairs (HON L LINARD)—

## **QUESTION**

Will the Minister detail the amount spent on commercial accommodation by Child Safety (reported separately by region and year for the last five years)?

## **ANSWER**

The Department of Children, Youth Justice and Multicultural Affairs utilises short term commercial accommodation for a variety of circumstances when caring for young people in the child protection system. These circumstances include emergency accommodation, relief accommodation and family contact accommodation requirements.

As regional boundaries have changed over this period, the allocation of expenditure is based on the 2021-22 regional structure.

Commercial accommodation expenditure for young people in the child protection system, by region and from 2018-19, is summarised below:
