MRS A CAMM ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the Local Highway Patrol Hours for the Whitsunday Electorate for the last 6 months reported separately by (a) month, (b) the number of fines issued and (c) the number of tickets issued for speeding, seatbelt and drug driving?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the Whitsunday electorate falls within the Mackay Police District and includes the police divisions of Whitsunday, Proserpine, Calen, Bowen, Mackay, Seaforth, Farleigh and parts of Mirani, Mackay Northern Beaches, Finch Hatton and Marian.

I am advised by the QPS the below tables outline the information requested by the Member.
