QUESTION:

With reference to the '100 Day Plan- Immediate actions' in the Tourism Industry Reference Panel's Interim Action Plan for Tourism Recovery—

Will the Minister provide the completion date and how the government has addressed each recommendation (reported by recommendation)?

ANSWER:

The Interim Action Plan for Tourism Recovery released by the Tourism Industry Reference Panel (the Panel) in October 2021 focused on the immediate needs of the tourism industry in anticipation of rapid recovery.
